TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Be advised that under Title VI of the Federal Civil Rights Act of 1964, the WVHCS, Inc. does admit and serve patients equally, without regard to sex, race ancestry, age, handicap, color, national origin or religious creed. The assignment of rooms, beds, and services, whether for care of an outpatient or for admission or transfer within the Hospital or for referral to other facilities, is made without regard to race, color, ancestry, handicap, national origin or religious creed of other patients.

Further, be advised that applications from physicians for staff privileges, prospective employees, the general public for the Volunteer service and trainees requesting admission to educational programs offered within the Hospital, are selected without regard to sex, race, ancestry, age, handicap, color, national origin or religious creed.

Members of the Medical Staff who have admitting privileges are also advised that Title VI requires that staff physicians select hospitals for their patients without regard to sex, race, ancestry, age handicap, national origin or religious creed.
